#### **C. ALLIES & PROVIDERS**

Individuals, and business entities that offer products and services such as drilling; leasing; marketing of natural gas or crude oil; pipeline construction and operation; well management and service; logging; engineering; consulting; legal or accounting services; and other such support and similar goods or services related to the exploration, production, marketing, transportation, distribution and delivery of Pennsylvania natural gas or crude oil. Allies and Providers Members are entitled to vote.
